




## Interment Order



All footstones shall be set flush with the lawn surface so that no part of such footstone shall protrude above the surface of the ground. The location of all headstones and footstones shall be approved by the Sexton.

The undersigned agrees to hold harmless the town and its servants if they act in prudence and good faith and a problem should arise.
