



Broadband Update: Marlow, NH

FairPoint Completes Marlow Upgrade of Broadband Service to Offer Higher Speeds

FairPoint Communications¹ and Town Officials met recently to review broadband availability in Marlow and want to share the following information.

Following recent investments to upgrade the equipment serving the town, approximately 87% of all Marlow addresses now qualify for DSL broadband download speeds of 7 Mbps² or more; approximately 47% qualify for speeds of 15 Mbps or more; and those closest to the Marlow central office could qualify for up to 25 Mbps. Today, 61% of FairPoint subscribers in Marlow are "under-subscribing" meaning that they are eligible for a higher speed than what has been purchased.

Now that FairPoint has upgraded broadband services in areas throughout the town, more residents and businesses in Marlow can quickly e-mail photos, stream videos, download music, and surf the Internet.

FairPoint also offers carrier-class Ethernet Business services with symmetrical up- and down-load speeds from 5 Mbps to 1 Gbps pending any access build costs.
