

SELECT BOARD ZOOM MEETING MAY 11, 2020

Present: Robert Allen, Thomas Fuschetto, Barry Corriveau & Jacqui Fay

Quorum declared.

Roll Call: Judi Boivin, Sean Brewer, Jim Strickland & Gwen Bishop.

Reviewed and signed check manifest for \$6,124.64.

Review deposit for \$260.

Jim Strickland asked to renew permission for the Hidden Valley Sn - Riders to use the trail through town owned property Map 202 Lot 006 - 001. Select Board voted to give the club indefinite permission with the provision that it can be revoked at any time. Jimmy Strickland also asked for details of the Rock subdivision.

Gwen Bishop asked whether the Select Board could abate taxes on a recent timber cut that had occurred on her property. Gwen was advised that the first step was to submit her 'Report of Cut'. The Select Board would then review what provisions there are to abate taxes and if so whether Gwen met the qualifications.

Judi Boivin discussed the cell tower by special exception application to the Planning Board. If social distance restrictions have been eased by June 9 this will be the date of the next Planning Board meeting. The balloon is scheduled to fly between 8 and 11am on June 2 to give a visual for the height of the tower. Discussed how to notify the public about this.

Sean Brewer confirmed Engine #2 is in service as of Saturday, registration documents have been sent in.

Reviewed April Trustee reports.



Discussed COVID-19 funding and drafting of new protocols for town buildings.


Discussed status of Lake Host program
