

**SELECT BOARD ZOOM MEETING JULY 20, 2020**

A start up meeting was held with representatives from the NH Department of Revenue Administration (DRA) and the Town's assessing company Commerford, Neider & Perkins was held regarding the revaluation. The town does a cyclical valuation and values are reset every five years, 2020 being the fifth and final year of the current valuation. The work will start next week and is due to be completed early September.

Tom Willey wanted to know the current status on forming a Broadband Advisory group. Barry Corriveau to research.

Judi Boivin briefed the board that the school as of now will be available for the Planning Board meeting. The Select Board discussed with Dan Cherry and Judi what the protocols would be. It was noted that there are no guarantees that the school will stay available given the ever changing pandemic situation.

Current water cooler contract has been cancelled by provider since it is not cost effective to deliver out here. Given COVID 19 it was decided that we should proceed with bottled water and fridges for the Town Office and Highway Department.

Town property sale has taken place, payment is being mailed to the Town Office.


Signed abatement for Map 405 Lot 017.
