The Transfer Station is here to help the residents recycle their household waste in the most efficient and effective way.

Facility Rules

This facility is for the exclusive use of residents of Marlow and the Ashuelot/Washington Pond area of Washington, NH. Only trash generated in these households is permitted.

A Marlow recycling permit decal should be visible on the vehicle. These decals can be obtained at the Town Office with proof of residency.

Vehicles bear right as they enter the facility through the gate. Traffic flows one way, counterclockwise around the facility. The middle lane going around the compactor must be kept open for traffic flow. Please follow attendants' directions.

See through bags are encouraged for all household trash placed in the compactor. Your trash may be inspected by the on-duty attendant to insure compliance. Access to this facility may be revoked for failing to comply with facility rules.

THE ON-DUTY ATTENDANT IS AVAILABLE TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS.

SWAP SHOP

The Marlow Transfer Station & Recycling Center offers a Swap Shop for residents of Marlow and Ashuelot/Washington Pond Road area of Washington, NH.

Residents are encouraged to shop and drop off items that are clean, useable and in working condition. All items being dropped off must be approved by the onduty attendant. NO clothing, shoes or anything with a plug will be accepted. NO electronic or hazardous waste will be accepted.

Disposal fees must still be paid on relevant items being placed in the Swap Shop. This covers the Town's cost of disposal.

The Swap Shop is a community effort. Users of the Swap Shop are expected to keep it neat and tidy. Having an open Swap Shop is a privilege and a benefit to all. Please do not abuse this privilege by attempting to leave items that are not accepted.

MIXED PAPER mail, newspaper, office paper, magazines, shredded

paper, clipboard (cereal and food boxes)

NO pizza boxes, beer/soda cartons, plastic bags, waxed containers, used paper plates and cups, corrugated cardboard, frozen food cartons

GLASS rinsed, without caps/lids

food and beverage jars and bottles

NO glassware, cups/mugs, dishware, Yankee candles window panes, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramics, etc.
